The D Vickers Memorial Scholarship

The D Vickers Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually to a student majoring in a B.A. curriculum offered by the English Department. The scholarship pays \$250.00 per semester for one academic year. A student may receive this scholarship only once.

To qualify, a student in a major offered by the English Department must satisfy the following **requirements**:

have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA through the semester of application;

have 30 semester hours or more of the academic credit by the time the award becomes effective;

be full-time student (minimum 12 hours) at Southeastern during the semesters the award is in effect;

have registered for at least one Honors course.

Retention of the scholarship for the second semester requires a minimum 3.0 GPA at the end of the first semester, continuing enrollment in a curriculum offered by the English Department, and enrollment in at least one Honors course during the year of the award.

An application consists of the following:

a completed application form;

the student's written statement of goals and aspirations (approximately 500 words); a copy of the transcript of the student's university courses;

two letters of recommendation, one from the Honors Director, and one from an English faculty member.

Award process: The Department Scholarship Committee will evaluate applications and select a recommended candidate to forward to the Department Head, who will make the final decision. The application deadline is April 20 for an award to begin in the following fall. The award will be announced at the end of the spring semester soon after grades are posted.
