Admission Requirements

To be considered for admission to the degree, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Meet SLU Graduate School criteria (e.g., have earned an undergraduate degree from an accredited college/university, be in satisfactory academic standing at the last university attended).
- 2. Complete an undergraduate degree in health, kinesiology, sport management or a related field.
- 3. Achieve either (a) a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher, or (b) a cumulative undergraduate GPA between 2.50 and 2.99 and a combined Verbal and Quantitative score of 286 or higher on the General Test of the Graduate Records Exam (GRE).

NOTE: Students who pursue the concentration in Exercise Science must have completed undergraduate courses in human anatomy and physiology (lecture+lab, 4 hours) and exercise physiology (3 hrs). Students without these prerequisite courses will be required to complete them in the first semester(s) of graduate enrollment.

Application Process

To be considered for admission to the program, you must complete an online application and pay an application fee. The application process includes submitting official copies of all transcripts, GRE scores if applicable, and a completed immunization form.
