## TRUMPET

Lead (use Trumpet 1 part)

Big Dipper, one measure before Letter B to C, Letter C to D  
Basic-Ally Yours, Letter A, first 10 measures

Section (use Trumpet 2 part)

Big Dipper, one measure before Letter B to C, Letter C to D  
Basic-Ally Yours, Letter A, first 10 measures

## TROMBONE

Lead (use Trombone 1 part)

Big Dipper, one measure before Letter B to C, Letter C to D  
Basic-Ally Yours, Letter A, first 10 measures (with pickups)

Section (use Trombone 2 part)

Big Dipper, one measure before Letter B to C, Letter C to D  
Basic-Ally Yours, Letter A, first 10 measures (with pickups)

## RHYTHM SECTION

Prepare the following charts: Big Dipper, Basic-Ally Yours

Bb blues:      Piano / Guitar / Bass - Comp / Time for two choruses, solo for two choruses  
                    Drums - Time for two choruses, trade fours for two choruses
