- Minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average
- Must be enrolled full time at Southeastern
- Must be enrolled in an Industrial/Organizational (I/O) Psychology concentration program
- A typed 2-page essay explaining your aspirations in the field of I/O psychology and financial needs should be included with your application materials.
- In order to ensure consideration, all application materials must be received by the deadline (March 20).

APPROXIMATELY \$250.00 WILL BE AWARDED ONCE IN THE FALL SEMESTER AND ONCE IN THE SPRING SEMESTER (the exact amount fluctuates based on market average value).
