Federal Pell Grant

- Determined by your EFC
- Undergraduate students only
- Can be adjusted based on your enrollment status
- Funds you receive over your lifetime are limited by federal law to be the equivalent of six years
- Maximum award = \$7,395 annually

Additional Grants



Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG)

For undergraduates with exceptional financial need, students with the lowest (EFC)

Gives priority to students who receive Federal Pell Grants



Louisiana Go Grant

Limitedly funded state grant program and the award is based on financial need.

For Louisiana residents who have remaining financial need after deducting all federal/state/institutional grant or scholarship aid

Federal Student Loans Subsidized vs. Unsubsidized

The Subsidized loan is a need-based loan that the federal government pays the interest on while you are in school.

For both loans, repayment begins six months after graduating, dropping below six hours, withdrawing, and/or stop attending school.

Unsubsidized loan interest starts to accrue as soon as it is disbursed.



Private Loans

- Available to students who are not eligible for federal aid or who need additional funds to meet educational expenses
- Student/Parent applies directly through private loan lender's website
- We encourage students to visit multiple lenders' websites to verify interest rates, repayment options, fees charged, and borrower benefits.

Work Study

- Students must be eligible to work in the United States.
- Students must be currently enrolled at least half-time at Southeastern.





The Southeastern Promise

A Guaranteed Path to Four-Year Graduation at Fixed Net Tuition Rate

How does it work?

- •Must enroll as a first-time freshman before last day of class of Fall semester
- •Selects major before Priority Registration of spring semester of first academic year
- •Must complete 30 hours per academic year towards selected degree program (Fall, Spring, Summer)
- •Student, with guidance from Academic Advisor, follows curriculum plan
- •Maintains good academic standing and 2.0 cumulative GPA

Eligibility:

Completion of a minimum of 15 Southeastern dual enrollment credits with a grade of "C" or better

Full-time enrollment at Southeastern for the first Fall semester following their high school graduation

\$1,000 (\$500 Fall; \$500 Spring)

Only for their first year at Southeastern

Contingent on the availability of funds

Dual Enrollment 15+ Completion Scholarship









The Southeastern Payment Plan

- →Allows students to pay their tuition and fees in payments versus one lump sum
- → Fall and Spring 3 installments
- →Summer 2 installments
 - \$45 enrollment fee
 - 1st installment + enrollment fee due by Fee Payment Deadline
 - 2nd installment due 30 days after Fee Payment Deadline
 - 3rd installment due 60 days after Fee Payment Deadline




