

Southeastern's new admission standards are intended to help ensure academic success of students and enhance the quality of academic programs.

## Students

Beginning with the Fall 2000 semester, Southeastern initiated its new quality admission standards with a goal of attracting more academically prepared students. The new standards require entering freshman to have either an ACT composite score of at least 20, rank in the upper $50 \%$ of their high school class, or have a high school grade point average of 2.0 in core academic courses. With the implementation of the new standards, the average ACT score for this fall's beginning freshmen rose from 19.0 to 19.8.
