

Study Abroad and International Initiatives

2013 - 2014 Highlights

- » The Office of International Initiatives works to increase the global vision of the students of Southeastern Louisiana University by providing participants with cross-cultural and international experiences essential to success in a global economy and to strengthen the educational, economic, and social relations between the United States and other countries. The office accomplishes this goal using a two-pronged approach offering Study Abroad programs led and taught by Southeastern faculty members and joining with partner institutions across the globe to provide opportunities for student and faculty exchanges.
- » Each summer dozens of Southeastern students expand their global view by participating in a study abroad experience. Southeastern students have travelled to many foreign destinations including China, Costa Rica, Panama, Italy, Spain, France, England, Scotland, Ireland, Germany, and Austria.
- » For summer 2013, a total of twelve programs were offered. Nine of these offerings had sufficient enrollment to run. A total of 150 students participated in study abroad during summer 2013.

- » In addition to summer programs, Southeastern currently has student/faculty exchange agreements with 25 international institutions in Canada and in Asian, European, and Latin American nations. Through these agreements, foreign students are encouraged to attend Southeastern and Southeastern students are given the opportunity to spend a semester or a year studying at a partner institution.
