The division offers a variety of camps during the summer and is also responsible for reserving Southeastern's facilities for third party groups.

Accomplishments of Extended Studies during the 2012-2013 academic year include:

- » 583 students enrolled in non-credit courses resulting in 275.75 CEU's awarded
- » 253 students participated in one of the 10 Summer Camp Programs
