In June 2016, the China Studies Institute (CSI) invited fourteen Zhi-Xing China Academic Impact Fellows chosen from university faculties across the United States to visit China. Dr. Kent Neurburg, as Director of International Initiatives, was representing Southeastern. During this three-week program the Fellows traveled to Shanghai, Xi'an, and Beijing, meeting with many university officials, professors, and industry and government representatives. The purpose of the Institute was to expose American university faculty members to China and pave the way for future international agreements and exchanges. The Institute was co-sponsored by the China Education Association for International Exchange (CEAIE) and the American Association of State Colleges and Universities (AASCU). The visitation to China and discussions with faculty

and international exchange staff from several Chinese institutions may lead to potential partnership with

chinese institutions.
