# Graduation Rates by Major Fall 2002 Cohort

### **Executive Summary**

The first strategic priority in Vision 2010 is to provide competitive educational opportunities that attract diverse well-prepared students who progress and graduate. This report provides several measures to help departments measure their success in progressing and graduating students. The report includes: Retention/Progression/Graduation Rates by major, department, and college; time-to-degree by major; Academic Progress Rates by department and college.

Majors in the College of Business graduate within their original major at a higher rate than the rest of the University, 17.4%, while those in the Division of General Studies have the lowest graduation rate in their original major (3.7%). Overall, the students who started in the College of Education & Human Development graduate at the highest rate (39.2%). The department of Accounting had the highest rate of those graduating in their original major (20.7%) while Chemistry & Physics had the lowest rate (1.9%). When looking at all graduates, regardless of the major they graduated in, those who started in Teaching & Learning had the highest rate of graduation (46.8%) while Chemistry & Physics had the lowest (11.5%).

Another measure in this report is the average-time-to-degree. For each major the number of semesters on average it took for students to obtain a degree is displayed. This measure indicates the number of semesters enrolled at Southeastern including the semester of graduation. This figure does not include transfer students. Overall, the average time it took for a student to obtain a degree was 11.8 semesters. The longest time-to-degree for majors was Special Education with 16.0 semesters. Family and Consumer Sciences and Social Studies Education were close behind with 14.1 and 13.8 semesters respectively. French, Chemistry, Horticulture, and English had the quickest time-to-degree with 7.0, 9.0, 9.0 and 9.5 semesters respectively.

The Academic Progress Rate (APR) is another measure which looks at retention and eligibility of all students, not just first time students. The NCAA originally developed the metric to assess the success of athletic teams, they established by NCAA that an APR score of 925 equates to a 50% graduation rate. The College of Education and Human Development had the highest APR at 891, while the Center for Student Excellence had the lowest (705). Among academic colleges, the College of Science & Technology had the lowest APR, 816. None of the departments met the 925 criteria, with Music & Dramatic Arts coming the closest at 912, followed by Cultural Resource Management (909), Teaching & Learning (902), and Communication Sciences and Disorders (900).

### **Graduation Rates by Major**

### Introduction

This report takes a longitudinal look at a beginning cohort of students. This cohort was tracked for six years in order to analyze the retention and graduation patterns of Southeastern's students. The analysis took first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen in the Fall of 2002 and tracked them for six years through Summer of 2008. This report includes graduation rates, progression rates, time-to-degree, and Academic Progress Rates by major.

#### **Graduation Rates**

The National Center for Educational Statistics' Integrated Postsecondary Educational Data Systems' (IPEDS) definition of graduation rates is the basis of this report. IPEDS considers a student graduated if that student has graduated within one hundred and fifty percent of normal time. Graduation rates are provided by major, by department, by college and overall for the university.

### Cohort

The cohort is defined as first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students who entered Southeastern in the Fall of 2002 or started in Summer 2002 and were enrolled full-time in the fall. First-time students are those students who have not attended any postsecondary institution prior to attending Southeastern. Students who earn college credit while in high school are considered first-time, if they enroll the Fall following a Spring graduation. Full-time students are those who are enrolled in twelve or more credit hours. Students must have been classified in a degree-seeking major their first semester; students in Special Programs for Adults are excluded.

### **Progression**

An indicator of students' progression is part of this report. The students were tracked to see if they had obtained a higher classification for each successive fall semester. Therefore, in Fall 2003 progression indicates the number of students who were enrolled as sophomores. Likewise, this progression indicator for Fall 2004 and Fall 2005 indicates the number of students who were enrolled as juniors and seniors, respectively.

### **Average Time to Degree**

Those students who graduated with a baccalaureate degree during Summer 2008, Fall 2008 and Spring 2009 semesters were tracked backwards to determine the Average Time-to-Degree. This figure per major indicates the number of semesters enrolled at Southeastern including the semester of graduation. This figure does not include transfer students.

### **Academic Progress Rate (APR)**

The APR methodology used by the NCAA was adapted and applied to Southeastern's Fall 2007 undergraduate enrollment to determine an APR for each college and department. All students were included in the analyses, not just cohort students. Students could earn up to two points each for the Fall and Spring semester. In the Fall, a student earned one point for being in Good Standing at the end of the semester and one point for being enrolled in Spring 2008. Students who graduated in Fall 2007 automatically received two points. Students who were enrolled in Spring 2008 were give one point for being in Good Standing at the end of the semester and one point for being enrolled in Fall 2008. Students who graduated in Spring or Summer were given automatically two points for the Spring semester. The ratio between points possible and points earned was calculated for each department and college. A perfect score is 1000. Research indicates that an APR of 925 translates to a 50% graduation rate, and is used by the NCAA as the criteria for penalizing athletic teams.
