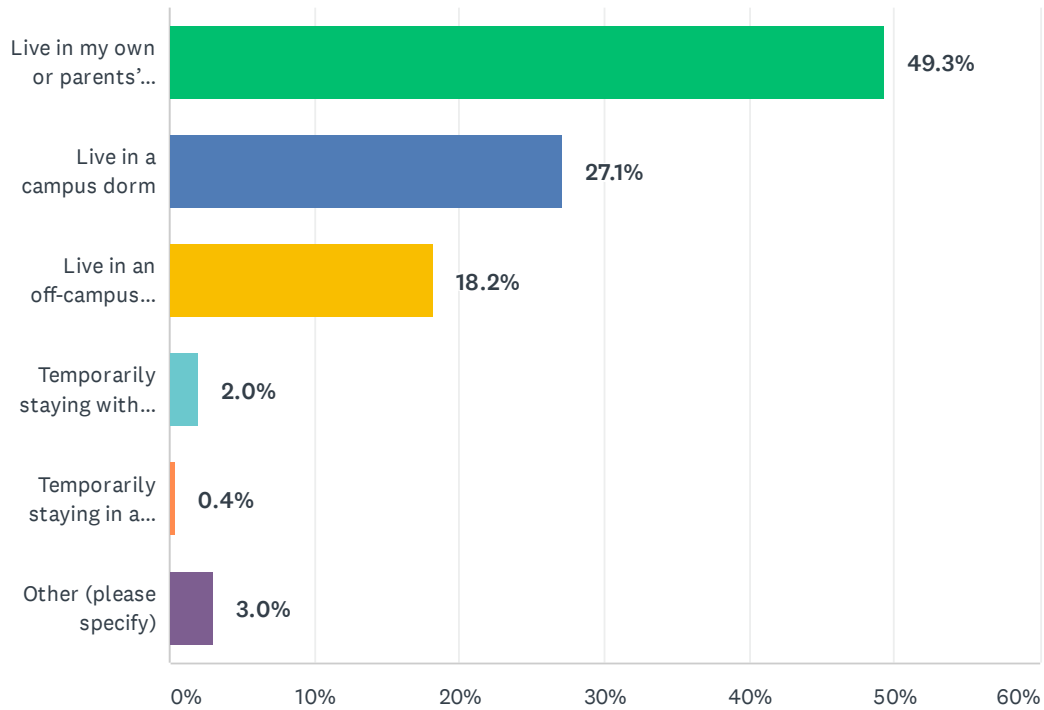


Q1 Which of the following best describes your current living situation?

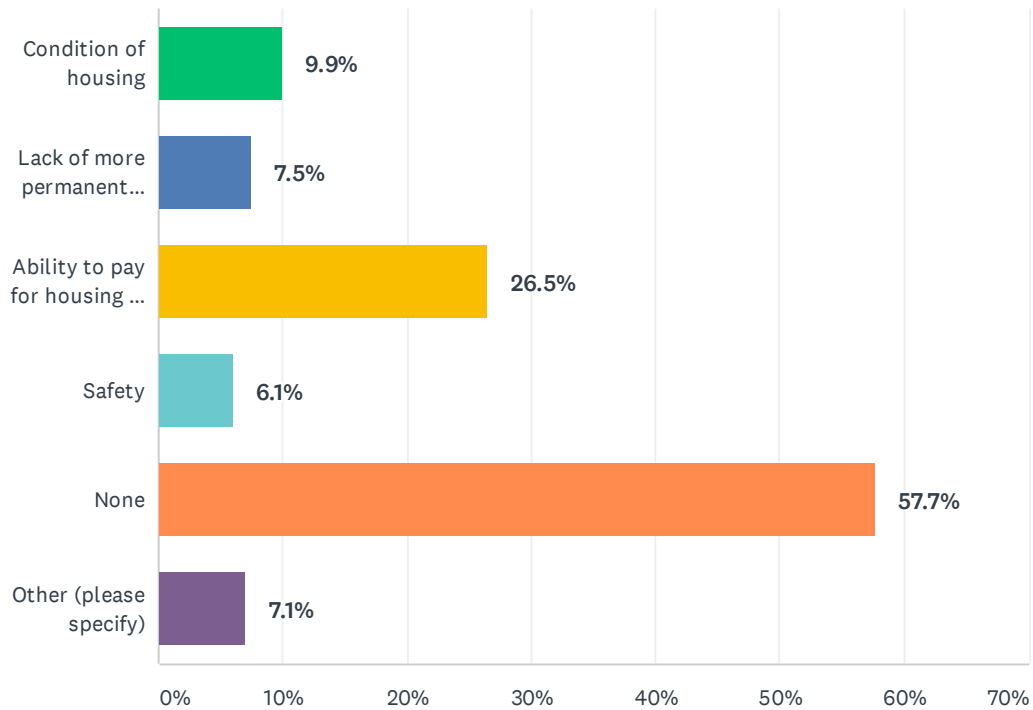

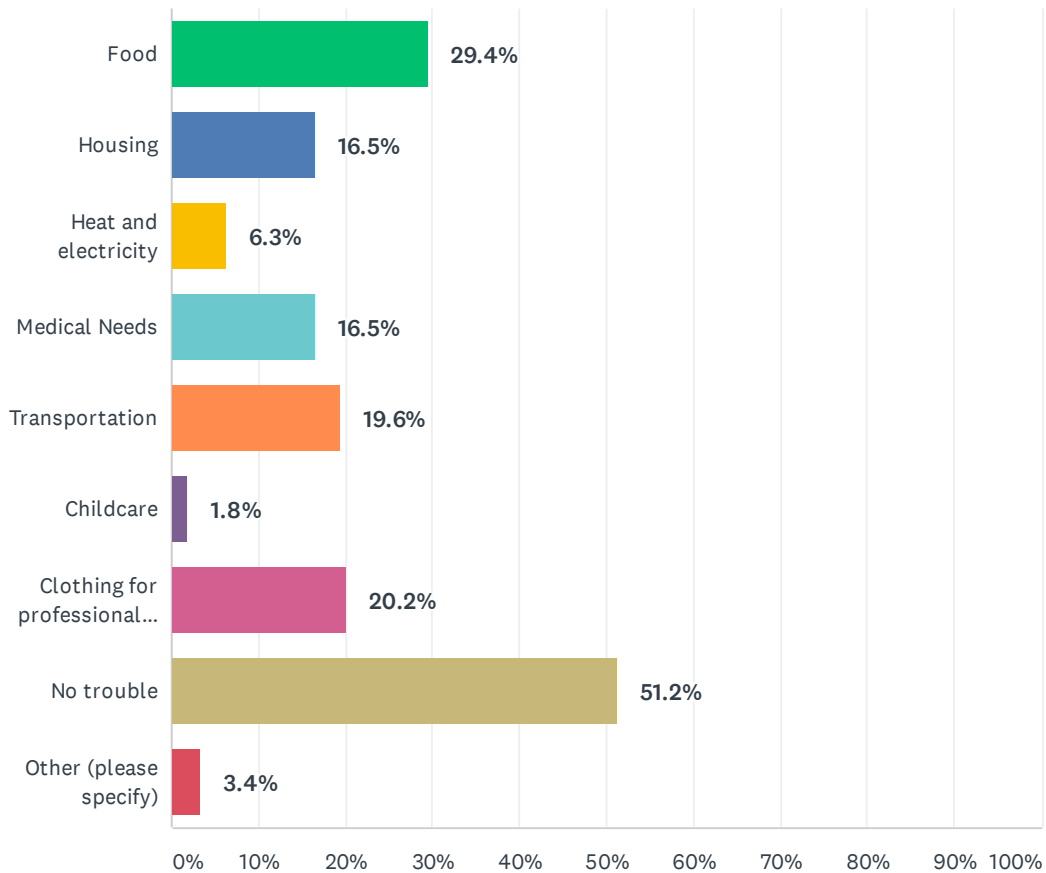

Q3 In the past three months, did you have trouble paying for any of the following. (Please mark all that apply)

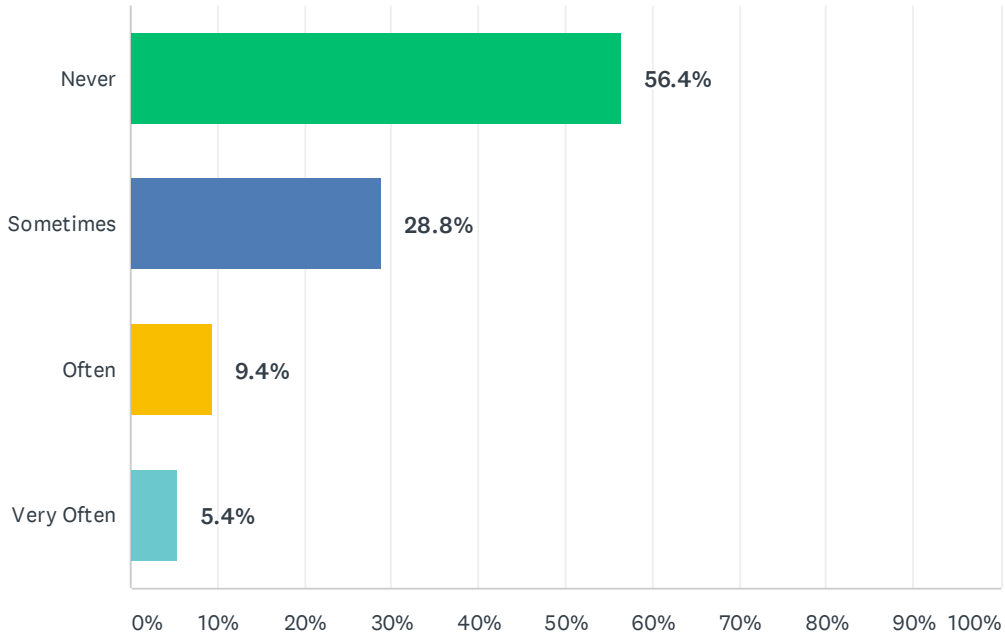

Q4 In the past three months, how often have you worried that your food would run out before you had money to buy more?

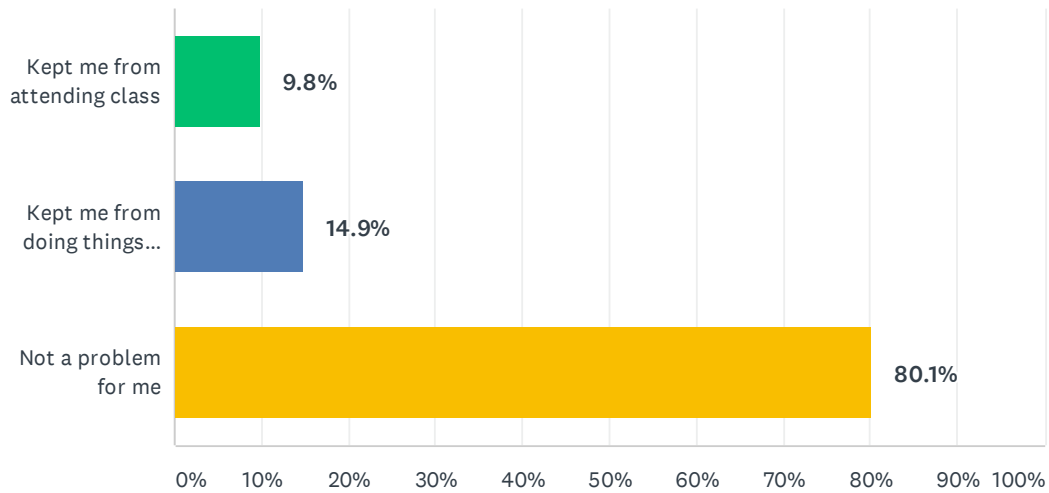

Q5 Has lack of transportation kept you from attending class or doing daily living tasks? (Please mark all that apply)

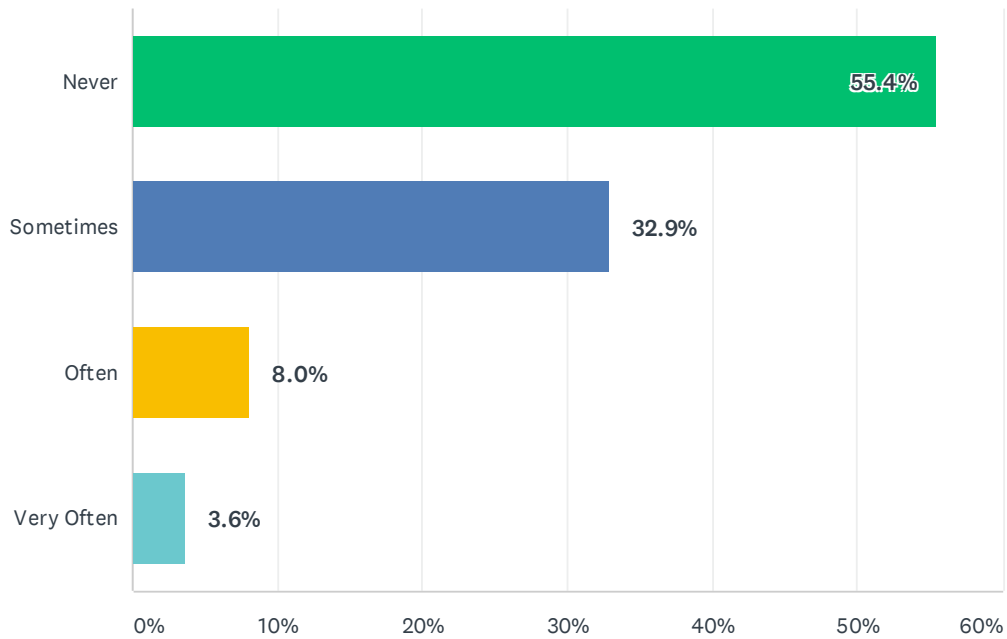

Q6 In the past three months, how often have family obligations kept you from attending class or studying?

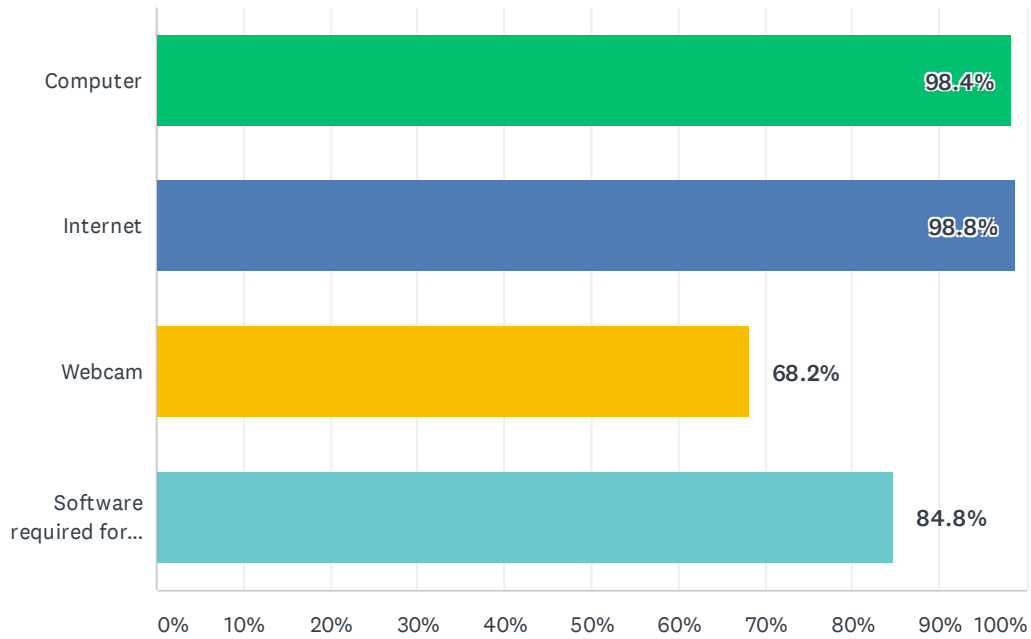

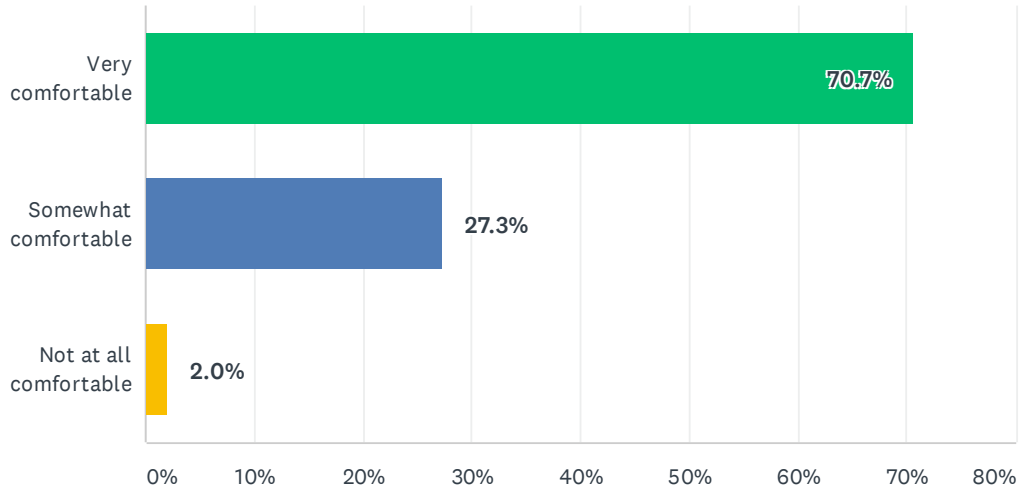

Q8 How comfortable are you with using technology as it relates to your education here at Southeastern?

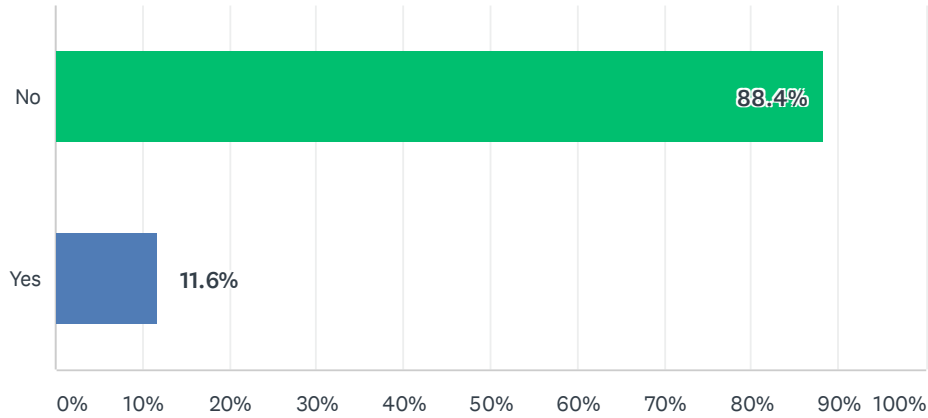

Q9 Did you have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) in high school or other special learning accommodations such as extended time for test taking?

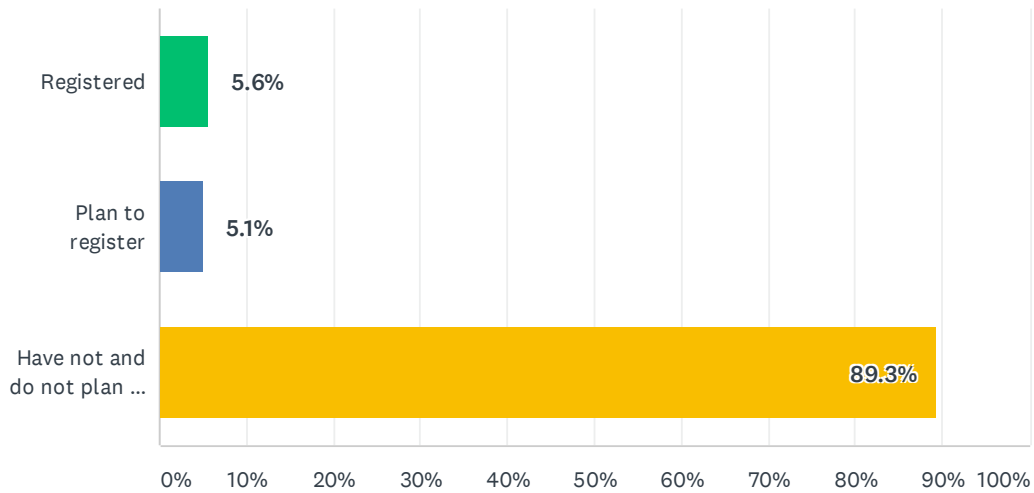

Q11 Have you registered with or do you plan to register with the Office of Disability Services?

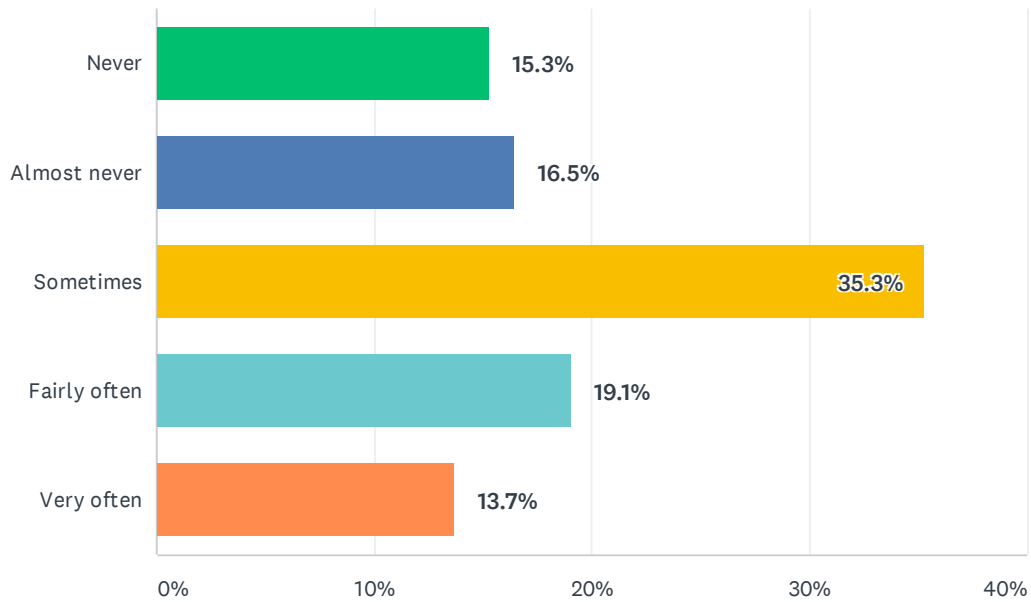

Q12 In the last month, how often have you felt difficulties were piling up so high that you could not overcome them?

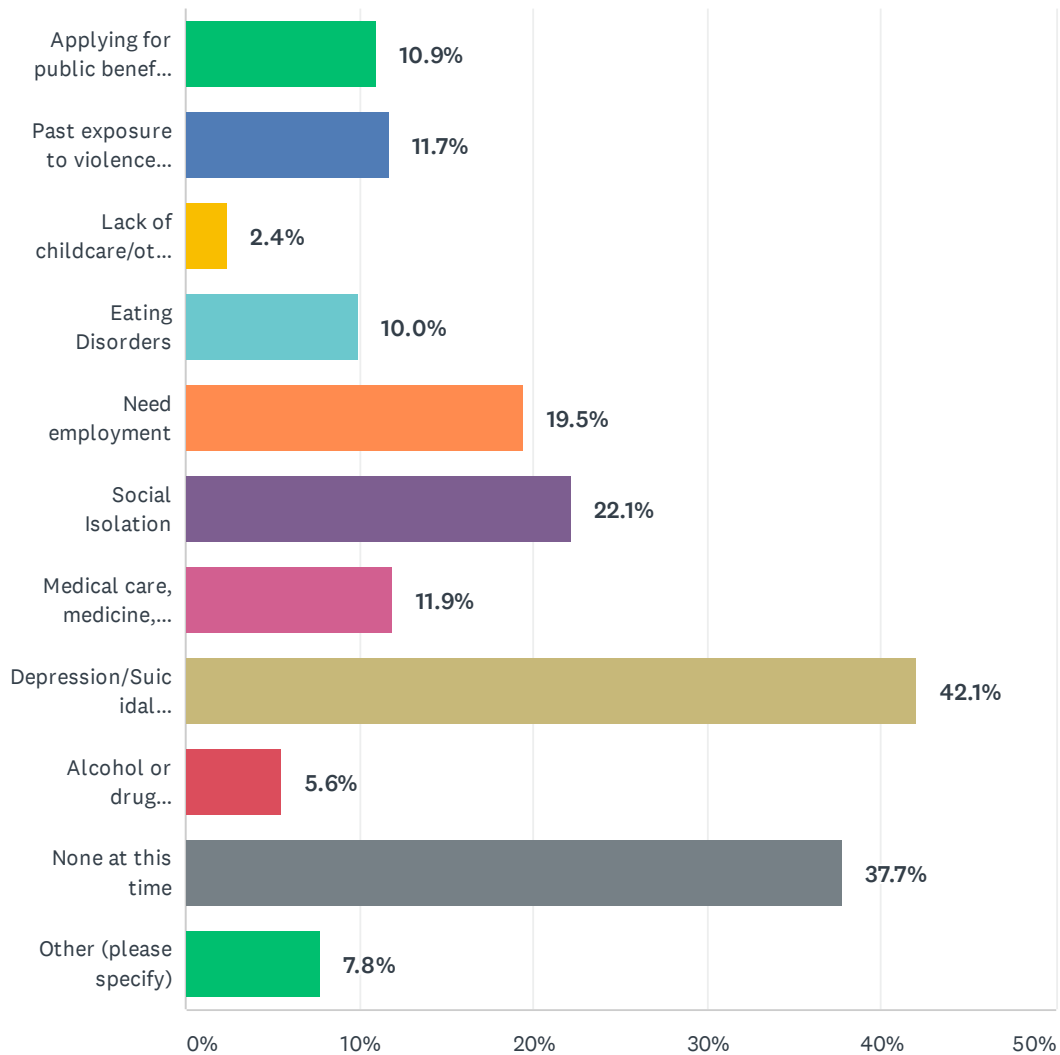

What would be helpful to you to remain here at Southeastern and obtain your degree?

212 responses to the open ended question. Below are some of the categories and then number of responses in that category.

- Tuition/Aid (20.8%, n=44) - Lower tuition and/or more financial aid/scholarships to be available.
- Other Financial (6.6%, n=14) - Financial issues not specifically about tuition, could be housing, child care, etc.
- Transportation (5.2%, n=11) - Includes transportation to and from local amenities and commuting
- Counseling (4.7%, n=10) - Either more counseling services or student needs to take advantage of what is available
- Classes (4.7%, n=10) - Would like to see more on-line courses or more term courses
- Faculty/Staff (4.3%, n=9) - More concern/understanding from faculty and or staff
- Graduating (4.3%, n=9) - Students are graduating this semester or next, so do not need help
- None (16.5%, n=35) - Respondents indicated that they do not need further help at this time.
- Other (33.0%, n=70) - Includes all other comments that were made by one or two individuals.
