

Southeastern seniors are less likely to complete a culminating student experience.

Southeastern freshmen rate the quality of their interactions with academic advisors higher.

Southeastern freshmen are less likely to have a discuss with people with different religious beliefs.

Southeastern freshmen and seniors are less likely to have a discuss with people of a different race.

Southeastern freshmen are less likely to have a discuss with people from a different economic background.

Southeastern freshmen are less likely to have a course with a community-based project.

Southeastern freshmen rate the quality of their interactions with other students lower.

Southeastern seniors rate the quality of their interactions with faculty higher.
