The NEA is the largest annual national funder of the arts in the United States. Since its inception, the NEA has awarded more than 135,000 grants, including early support for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial design competition, the Sundance Film Festival, Spoleto Festival USA, and PBS's *Great Performances* series. For more than four decades, the Arts Endowment has encouraged creativity through support of performances, exhibitions, festivals, artist residencies, and other arts projects throughout the country in a number of different disciplines/fields, including Artist Communities, Arts Education, Dance, Design, Folk and Traditional Arts, Literature, Local Arts Agencies, Media Arts, Museums, Music, Musical Theater, Opera, Presenting, Theater, and Visual Arts. The NEA also extends its impact through partnerships with federal agencies, state organizations, and other public and private organizations. Avon Offers Small Grants for Campus Violence Prevention

Applications are due by January 11, 2013.
