A. FA21-16 A Bill to Finance SGA Home Tailgating Through the Office of Programming and Special Projects

Representative: Grant serves to foster spirit during home games, will go towards anything needed to be funded for tailgate; important to fund students to get into game (tickets); tailgate is until 30 minutes before kickoff; tailgate is also for football, baseball, basketball

Senate Chair opens floor for discussion:

Sen. Watson: Appropriations discussed lowering the amount for Bill, estimating attendance, proposing doing \$2,500: \$1,500 for next spring.

Senate Chair: Funds may also be allocated for other SGA projects

Sen. Freeman: \$2,500 would cover budget for rest of the semester with safety net incase of second round of playoffs- with extra money left over for additional projects

Sen. Adams: Note that money will go back into SGA funds if unused

Sen. Freeman: No organized tailgates for baseball and basketball last season via ticket booth
