## CHAMPVA School Enrollment Certification Letter

Children between 18 and 23 years of age must submit a school enrollment certification letter confirming full-time student status. This is required in order to continue eligibility for CHAMPVA benefits. **NOTE:** School enrollment certification letters must be faxed directly from the school in order to be considered valid.
